At Paris 2024, professional-built events were overseen by the IOC's Paris Boxing Unit, and boxers with professional experience competed alongside amateurs. Several earned medals and made our country proud.

To build on this momentum and ensure stronger Indian representation at future Olympic Games Los Angeles 2028 and Olympic Games India 2036

Dr. Rakesh Mishra, President, Indian Amateur Boxing Federation (IABF) will be conducting the following professional-level:

- Pro Fight Nights
- Title Fights
- Indian Boxing League

These programs will provide a platform for Indian boxers to develop competitive records while still remaining eligible for Olympic qualification.

Boxers participating in the above-mentioned pro competitions will have their full fight records uploaded to BoxRec, ensuring transparency and global recognition.
